Report on Compliance with Requirements Applicable to Each Major Program and on Internal Control Over Compliance in Accordance with OMB Circular A-133 and Supplementary Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards

Compliance

We have audited the compliance of the University System of Maryland (the System) with the types of compliance requirements described in the U.S. Office of Management and Budget (0MB) *Circular A-133 Compliance Supplement* that are applicable to each of its major federal programs for the year ended June 30, 2001. The System's major federal programs are identified in the summary of auditors' results section of the accompanying schedule of findings and questioned costs. Compliance with requirements of laws, regulations, contracts, and grants applicable to each of its major federal programs is the responsibility of the System's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the System's compliance based on our audit.

We conducted our audit of compliance in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States; the standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards*, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States; and OMB Circular A-133, *Audits of States, Local Governments, and Non-Profit Organizations.* Those standards and OMB Circular A-133 require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether noncompliance with the types of compliance requirements referred to above that could have a direct and material effect on a major federal program occurred. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence about the System's compliance with those requirements and performing such other procedures as we consider necessary in the circumstances. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion. Our audit does not provide a legal determination on the System's compliance with those requirements.

In our opinion, the University System of Maryland complied, in all material respects, with the requirements referred to above that are applicable to each of its major federal programs for the year ended June 30, 2001. However, the results of our auditing procedures disclosed instances of noncompliance with those requirements that are required to be reported in accordance with 0MB Circular A-133 and which are described in the accompanying schedule of findings and questioned costs as Findings 200 1-1 to 2001-6.

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Internal Control over Compliance

The management of the System is responsible for establishing and maintaining effective internal control over compliance with requirements of laws, regulations, contracts, and grants applicable to federal programs. In planning and performing our audit, we considered the System's internal control over compliance with requirements that could have a direct and material effect on a major federal program in order to determine our auditing procedures for the purposes of expressing our opinion on compliance and to test and report on internal control over compliance in accordance with 0MB Circular A-133.

We noted certain matters involving the internal control over compliance and its operation that we consider to be reportable conditions. Reportable conditions involve matters coming to our attention relating to significant deficiencies in the design or operation of the internal control over compliance that, in our judgment, couid adversely affect the System's ability to administer a major federal program in accordance with applicable requirements of laws, regulations, contracts and grants. Reportable conditions are described in the accompanying schedule of findings and questioned costs as Findings 2001-1 to 2001-6.

A material weakness is a condition in which the design or operation of one or more of the internal control components does not reduce to a relatively low level the risk that noncompliance with applicable requirements of laws, regulations, contracts, and grants that would be material in relation to a major federal program being audited may occur and not be detected within a timely period by employees in the normal course of performing their assigned functions. Our consideration of the internal control over compliance would not necessarily disclose all matters in the internal control that might be reportable conditions and, accordingly, would not necessarily disclose all reportable conditions that are also considered to be material weaknesses. However, we believe none of the reportable conditions described above are material weaknesses.

We have audited the general purpose financial statements of the System as of and for the year ended June 30, 2001, and have issued our report thereon dated November 13, 2001. Our audit was performed for the purpose of forming an opinion on the general purpose financial statements taken as a whole.

The accompanying schedule of expenditures of federal awards is presented for purposes of additional analysis as required by U.S. Office of Management and Budget 0MB Circular A- 133, *Audits of States, Local Governments, and Non-Profit Organizations,* and is not a required part of the general purpose financial statements. Such information has been subjected to the auditing procedures applied in the audit of the general purpose financial statements and, in our opinion, is fairly stated, in all material respects, in relation to the general purpose financial statements taken as a whole.

1. Single Audit Reporting Entity

The System's single audit reporting entity includes all entities that comprise the System consistent with the reporting entity used for the System's financial statements.

2. Basis of Accounting

Expenditures in the Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards are presented on the accrual basis of accounting. Such expenditures were recorded when incurred, rather than when paid.

3. Categorization of Expenditures

The categorization of expenditures by program included in the Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards is based on the *Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance* (CFDA). Changes in the categorization of expenditures occur based on revisions to the CFDA, which are issued in June and December of each year. In accordance with the System's policy, the Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards for the year ended June 30, 2001, reflects CFDA changes issued through December 2000.

There were no findings related to the financial statements that were required to be reported in accordance with generally accepted *Government Auditing Standards* for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001.

Finding 2001-1

Research and Development Cluster

Condition: We reviewed 10 expenditures from research and development federal awards totaling \$626,642 for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001. From these 10, we reviewed six payroll transactions totaling \$117,008 out of a population of approximately \$56 million in payroll charges for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001. We noted that the University of Maryland, Baltimore (UMB) did not complete time and effort reports to substantiate payroll charges approximating \$38,000 to a Veterans Administration (VA) research and development contract (contract number V512P-274) for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001.

Additionally, upon review of the components of the \$38,000 in payroll charges to this contract, it was noted that a faculty member was still being paid a salary for two and half pay periods after the effective date of separation from the University. As a result, payroll charges of \$5,446 are questioned costs to the VA contract.

Criteria: OMB Circular A-21(J)(8)(c)(2)(b) requires that "these reports will reflect an after-the-fact reporting of the percentage distribution of activity of employees. Charges may be made initially on the basis of estimates made before the services are performed, provided that such charges are promptly adjusted if significant differences are indicated by activity reports."

OMB Circular A-21(J)(8)(c)(2)(c) "Reports will reasonably reflect the activities for which employees are compensated by the institution. To confirm that the distribution of activity represents a reasonable estimate of the work performed by the employee during the period, the reports will be signed by the employee, principal investigator, or responsible official(s) using suitable means of verification will sign the reports that the work was performed."

OMB Circular A-21(J)(8)(d)(1) requires that "charges for work performed on sponsored agreements by faculty members during the academic year will be based on the individual faculty member's regular compensation for the continuous period which, under the policy of the institution concerned, constitutes the basis of his salary."

Cause: The University of Maryland, Baltimore School of Medicine did not process the faculty member's Notice of Separation paperwork in a timely manner.

Finding 2001-1 (continued)

Effect: The payroll charges to this research and development contract during the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001 are not supported by time and effort reports resulting in approximately \$38,000 in questioned salary and wage costs. Of this approximately \$38,000, \$5,446 in unallowable charges to this contract were incurred.

Recommendation: We recommend that the UMB complete time and effort reports for all faculty and staff to support payroll charges to research and development grants during the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001 and for subsequent periods. The UMB should also pursue settlement of the questioned costs with the Veterans Administration, which would include reimbursing the Veterans Administration for the payroll charges of \$5,446.

Auditee Response and Corrective Action Plan: There was an error in the coding of the Veterans Administration account that caused the account to be designated as a service agreement where it should have been designated as a sponsored agreement. This oversight has been corrected and the effort reports for this contract are now being collected and should be completed by the end of October 2001. We will pursue settlement with the Veterans Administration for the \$5,446.

Auditors' Conclusion: Based on the above, the finding remains as stated.

Finding 2001-2

Research and Development Cluster

Condition: We noted that the UMB, a pass-through entity, did not adequately monitor subrecipients to ensure that those subrecipients that expended more than \$300,000 in Federal funds had met the audit requirements of OMB Circular A-133. We reviewed 35 subrecipient agreements and noted that for 22 subrecipients the UMB requested the subrecipient to certify their compliance with the audit requirements of OMB Circular A-133 for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1999 in June 2001. The audit reports for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1999 should have been received by UMB by March 31, 2000 for UMB to be in compliance with the subrecipient requirements of OMB Circular A-133. In addition, we noted that the UMB did not document its follow up of subrecipient audit findings reported in their A-133 audit reports, and did not follow up to ensure that the subrecipient took appropriate and timely corrective action.

Criteria: OMB Circular A-133.400 (d)(4) requires that "pass-through entities should ensure that subrecipients expending \$300,000 or more in federal awards during the subrecipient's fiscal year have met the audit requirements of this part." In addition, OMB Circular A-133.400 (d)(5) requires that the "pass-through entity issue a management decision on audit findings within six months after receipt of the subrecipient's audit report and ensure that the subrecipient takes appropriate and timely corrective action."

Cause: The UMB does not have an adequate system in place to monitor subrecipient compliance with the audit requirements in A-133.

Effect: Subrecipients are not being monitored in accordance with OMB Circular A-133.

Recommendation: We recommend that the UMB strengthen its procedures to adequately monitor subrecipient compliance with the audit requirements of OMB Circular A-133. In addition, we recommend that the UMB establish a spreadsheet to log in all subrecipient reports when received that includes the subrecipient's name, amount of federal funds received, due date of receipt of the A-133 audit report, and audit findings and evidence of follow up and a management decision on the findings.

Auditee Response and Corrective Action Plan: The UMB will ensure that procedures already in place are fully implemented and monitored. The existing subrecipient agreement database will be expanded to include all information referenced above.

Auditors' Conclusion: Based on the above, the finding remains as stated.

Finding 2001-3

CFDA Number 84.363-Federal Pell Grant Program

Condition: Pell Payment Data Reports (Origination Reports and Disbursement Reports) are not being submitted in the required 30-day timeframe after a Pell payment has been disbursed.

Towson University—During our testing of Student Financial Aid (Reporting) for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001, we noted that Towson University is not submitting Pell Payment Data Reports (Origination Reports and Disbursement Reports) in the required 30-day timeframe after a Pell payment has been disbursed. There were exceptions noted for all 4 students tested for the first semester.

University of Maryland, College Park—During our testing of Student Financial Aid (Reporting) for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001, we noted that University of Maryland, College Park is not submitting Pell Payment Data Reports (Origination Reports and Disbursement Reports) in the required 30-day timeframe after a Pell payment has been disbursed. For 6 out of the 10 students tested, the origination was not reported within the required timeframe. Also, for the first semester, for all of the 10 students tested, exceptions were noted that the disbursements were not reported within 30 days.

University of Maryland University College—During our testing of Student Financial Aid (Reporting) for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001, we noted that University of Maryland University College (UMUC) is not submitting Pell Payment Data Reports (Origination Reports and Disbursement Reports) in the required 30-day timeframe after a Pell payment has been disbursed. There were exceptions noted for 2 of the 4 students selected for testing for the Fall semester.

Criteria: The OMB Circular A-133 Compliance Supplement refers to 34 CFR 690.83 and 62 FR 31487 which "requires that the school must report student payment data within 30 calendar days after the school makes a payment; or becomes aware of the need to make an adjustment to previously reported student payment data or expected student payment data. Schools may do this by reporting once every 30 calendar days, bi-weekly, weekly or may set up their own system to ensure that changes are reported in a timely manner."

Finding 2001-3 (continued)

Cause:

Towson University—The University had some system problems in submitting the data files. They requested fix files from the Bowie computer center several times in trying to submit the required data files within the required timeframe.

University of Maryland, College Park—Financial aid is applied to students' accounts to aid in the billing process. Therefore, distribution dates cannot be ascertained from the student's Statement of Accounts, which is used by the Financial Aid Department to generate the Pell Payment Data Reports.

University of Maryland University College—The financial aid system called SAFERS, is set up to create an origination at disbursement if one was not created prior to disbursement. It appears that their system failed to perform this task for the above listed students. Coincidentally, both originations and disbursements for these two students were reported on the same date of April 10, 2001.

Effect: The Universities are not in compliance with the above regulations. As a result of not being in compliance the Universities drew down funds from DOE for disbursements that may not have been accepted for reimbursement because they were not subject to a review by DOE, which results in an undeterminable amount of questioned costs.

Recommendation: We recommend that the Universities submit the required Pell Payment Data Reports in the required timeframe in order to be in compliance with the previously mentioned regulations.

Auditee Responses and Corrective Action Plans:

Towson University—The 2000-2001 award year was the initial year for processing Pell grant originations and payment information using the existing computer software. Software related problems resulted in numerous delays in our ability to transmit data in a timely manner. This non-compliance was due to external factors (software vendor and Bowie Service Center issue resolution and testing) outside the realm of our control.

Finding 2001-3 (continued)

The 2000-2001 processing cycle resulted in the identification and resolution of most system related problems. This has served to insure improvements in the 2001-2002 processing and reporting cycle. The first Pell origination records for 2001-2002 were transmitted on August 31, 2001 for 1,237 students and acknowledged on September 7, 2001. The first Pell disbursement records were transmitted on September 14, 2001 and acknowledged on September 18, 2001. The jobs associated with these processes will be scheduled monthly to insure that we are in compliance.

University of Maryland, College Park—The University agrees with this finding. The software that the University uses to administer student financial aid did not properly generate the Pell Grant origination and disbursement records for the Fall 2000 semester. A fix to this software was installed on October 23, 2000. The origination records were submitted on October 25, 2000 and the disbursement records were submitted on November 10, 2000. The University is now in full compliance for the reporting of origination and disbursement.

University of Maryland University College—UMUC concurs with this audit finding. After careful review of the cause of this finding, we determined it could have been prevented if we had reviewed existing Rejection Reports. We have implemented procedures to generate Rejection Reports on a weekly bases, and correct and resubmit any errors on a timely basis. This will ensure that UMUC submits all Pell Origination records and Pell Disbursement records to the Department of Education within the timeframe required by Federal regulations.

Auditors' Conclusion: Based on the above, the finding remains as stated.

Finding 2001-4

Student Financial Assistance Cluster

Condition: A student status change occurred and the College did not report the change using Student Status Confirmation Report (SSCR) within the required 60-day period.

Coppin State College—During our testing of Student Financial Aid (Reporting) for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001, we noted that Coppin State College is not submitting the Student Status Change Report (SSCR) within the required 60-day period. There were exceptions noted for two out of the three students tested.

University of Maryland, Baltimore County—During our testing of Student Financial Aid (Reporting) for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001, we noted that University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC) is not submitting the SSCR within the required 60-day period. There were exceptions noted for two out of the four students for tested.

University of Maryland, College Park—During our testing of Student Financial Aid (Reporting) for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001, we noted that University of Maryland, College Park is not submitting the SSCR within the required 60-day period. There were exceptions noted for four out of the ten students selected for testing.

Criteria: The OMB Circular A-133 Compliance Supplement refers to HEAL 42 CFR section 60.53; FFEL, 34 CFR section 682.610; Direct Loan, and 34 CFR section 685.309, which require that "each school must notify the holder of the HEAL loan of any change in the student's enrollment status within 30 days following the change in status. The school must also notify the lender of any change in the student's name. Under the FFEL and Direct Loan programs, schools must complete and return within 30 days of receipt student status confirmation reports sent by the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS). Unless the school expects to complete its next student status report within 60 days, the school must notify NSLDS within 30 days, if it discovers that a student who received a loan either did not enroll or ceased to be enrolled on at least a half-time basis."

Finding 2001-4 (continued)

Cause:

Coppin State College—The College inadvertently terminated its contract with the National Student Loan Clearinghouse that sends the College's SSCR reports to the National Student Loan Data System. The problem was corrected immediately upon notification.

University of Maryland, Baltimore County—The University submitted the required information more than 60 days of the receipt of the student status confirmation report.

University of Maryland, College Park—The University submitted the required information more than 60 days of the receipt of the student status confirmation report.

Effect: The appropriate party cannot start the loan repayment process when a student withdrew or dropped during a period and the change in a student's status is not reported in a timely or accurate manner.

Recommendation: We recommend that the Universities submit the required SSCR in the required time frame in order to be in compliance with the regulations.

Auditee Responses and Corrective Action Plans:

Coppin State College—Coppin State College signed on with the National Student Loan Clearinghouse (NSLC) to be its designated Destination Point for NSLDS in March 1998. At the beginning, middle, and end of each semester, we send an electronic file to the Clearinghouse that updates our student enrollment. Every other month, NSLDS sends a roster to the NSLC to process. We have been in compliance since 1998.

On July 12, 2000, the College signed an agreement with the Department of Education to allow the transmitting of Perkins Loan data to and from NSLDS in this Office. This agreement was executed on July 25, 2000.

However, in applying for Perkins Loans services through NSLDS the participation agreement was prepared inaccurately causing Coppin to be dropped from the Clearinghouse. This problem was resolved immediately upon notification.

Finding 2001-4 (continued)

University of Maryland, Baltimore County—UMBC had two students whose student status changes were reported in 73 days rather than the 60 days required in the student status reporting timeline. Since we report our changes through the National Student Clearinghouse (NSLC), we our modifying our NSLC submission cycle to comply with the 60 day student status reporting timeline. During the spring 2002 term we will submit our last transmission 19 days earlier on June 2, 2002 rather than June 21, 2002. This will allow us to report the students who drop on the last official day to drop a class (April 8, 2002) within the 60-day window.

University of Maryland, College Park—We agree with this finding. Commencing in Spring 2002, the Registrar's Office will schedule an additional enrollment report each semester that will ensure all enrollment changes are reported within 60 days.

Auditors' Conclusion: Based on the above, the finding remains as stated.

Finding 2001-5

CFDA Number 10.500- Cooperative Extension Service

Condition: We reviewed 28 expenditures from the Cooperative Extension Service Program totaling \$492,304 for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001. From these 28, we reviewed 20 payroll transactions totaling \$140,630 out of a population of approximately \$3.7 million in payroll charges for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001. We noted that the University of Maryland College Park did not complete after-the-fact confirmations to substantiate payroll charges related to on-campus faculty for nine transactions totaling \$77,408 that were charged to the Cooperative Extension Service Program.

Criteria: OMB Circular A-21 J 8 (b) (2) (a -b) requires that "the payroll distribution system will (i) be incorporated into the official records of the institution, (ii) reasonably reflect the activity for which the employee is compensated by the institution, and (iii) encompass both sponsored and all other activities on an integrated basis, but may include the use of subsidiary records.

"The method must recognize the principle of after-the-fact confirmation or determination so that costs distributed represent actual costs, unless a mutually satisfactory alternative agreement is reached."

OMB Circular A-21 J 8 (c) (1) (e) states "At least annually a statement will be signed by the employee, principal investigator, or responsible official(s) using suitable means of verification that the work was performed, stating that salaries and wages charged to sponsored agreements as direct charges, and to residual, F&A cost or other categories are reasonable in relation to work performed."

OMB Circular A-21 J 8 (c) (2) (b) (c) states "these reports will reflect an after-the-fact reporting of the percentage distribution of activity of employees. Charges may be made initially on the basis of estimates made before the services are performed, provided that such charges are promptly adjusted if activity records indicate significant differences.

(c) Reports will reasonably reflect the activities for which employees are compensated by the institution. To confirm that the distribution of activity represents a reasonable estimate of the work performed by the employee during the period, the employee,

principal investigator, or responsible official(s) using suitable means of verification will sign the reports that the work was performed."

Cause: The University of Maryland College Park did not complete after-the-fact confirmations of time and effort for faculty and staff that split their time performing Cooperative Extension Service and other work because it does not believe the related provisions of OMB Circular A-21 apply to Cooperative Extension Service funds.

Effect: The payroll charges to the land grant during the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001 are not supported with acceptable after-the-fact confirmation of time and effort in accordance with OMB Circular A-21 resulting in approximately \$77,408 in questioned salary and wage costs.

Recommendation: We recommend that the University of Maryland College Park establish procedures to complete after the fact confirmations for all on-campus faculty and staff that work on multiple assignments to support payroll charges for on-campus faculty to the Cooperative Extension Service during the fiscal year ended June 30, 2001.

Auditee Response and Corrective Action Plan: The University disagrees with this finding. The University has written to the United States of Management and Budget for an interpretation of the applicability of OMB Circular A-21, J.8 on the nine transactions cited. The U.S. Department of Agriculture, Extension Service, Administrative Handbook, Chapter III, Financial Operations, Section K – Use of Federal and Offset Funds, 2. Allowable Items of Expenditures, b. Compensation for Personal Services (3-28), states "The Department [of Agriculture] requested a clarification from OMB on payroll certification for those Extension employees whose entire (100%) salary comes from Federal Extension funds. OMB concurred with the Department's interpretation that these employees are exempt from the payroll certification provisions of Circular A-21." The University position is that is counter-intuitive that an employee who is paid 100% from CES funds is exempt, but that a person who is paid exclusively by both exempt sources would be subject to the "J.8." effort reporting requirements.

Auditors' Conclusion: The United States Department of Agriculture (program administrators) advised us that the provisions of OMB Circular A-21 applied to Cooperative Extension Service funds.

We concur with the University's course of action and await the OMB's interpretation of the applicability of the Circular on the transaction cited. Based on the above, the finding remains as stated.

Finding 2001-6

CFDA Number 10.500- Cooperative Extension Service

Condition: We noted that the University of Maryland College Park College of Agriculture and Natural Resources used Cooperative Extension Service funds totaling approximately \$60,000 for unallowable activities such as the renovation of classrooms and laboratories in the Animal Sciences and Agricultural Engineering Building. The renovations were funded via a transfer to a Cooperative Extension Service Program account from a University account.

Criteria: United States Code (USC) title 7 section 345 states "no portion of said moneys shall be applied, directly or indirectly, to the purchase, erection, preservation, or repair of any building or buildings, or the purchase or rental of land, or in college-course teaching, lectures in college, or any other purpose not specified in this subchapter."

Cause: The University of Maryland College Park renovations charged to the program were funded via a transfer to a Cooperative Extension Service account from a University account.

Effect: Cooperative Extension Service funds were used for unallowable activities resulting in appropriately \$60,000 in questioned costs. The University of Maryland College Park subsequently reversed the charge to the Cooperative Extension Service after completion of the audit.

Recommendation: We recommend that the University of Maryland College Park establish procedures to adequately limit the use of funds for allowable activities. The University of Maryland College Park has already reversed the charge to the Cooperative Extension Service Program grant thus reducing their next draw down. No further action is needed on their part.

Finding 2001-6 (continued)

Auditee Responses and Corrective Action Plan: The University agrees with the finding. Although the cost of building renovations are allowable under United States Office of Management and Budget Circular A-21, it is understood that this type of expenditure is not allowable under United States Code (USC) title 7. The University has reimbursed the federal government for this single expenditure. Further, the Office of the Comptroller has contacted the Office of the Dean of the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources and the Office of Facilities Management to reinforce the prohibition on the use of Cooperative Extension Service funds for renovations. The Office of the Dean now reviews all charges for renovations. The Property Accounting Office and the Office of Contract and Grant Accounting within the Office of the Comptroller are screening for expenditures of this type.

Auditors' Conclusion: Based on the above, the finding remains as stated.
